

# Central Mass Horse Show Series & Camp Marshall COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols

CMHSS and Camp Marshall thank you for your support and your cooperation in helping keep our staff, volunteers, exhibitors and spectators as safe as possible during this time. While the threat of COVID-19 has significantly decreased from when it began, it is still out there and we must take precautions at all times. These COVID-19 protocols are in place to keep everyone safe, they must be followed at all times. Being unsafe, not following guidelines as asked, can result in dismissal from property.

## COVID-19 Guidelines and Protocols:

- At all times when waiting in lines for bathrooms, the show office, concessions etc. all persons are recommended to maintain six (6) feet of social distance.
- It is recommended that all persons wear a face covering of some kind per the CDC, however, all persons NOT vaccinated must wear a face covering when at the show office, concession booth or when persons not from your party.
- All bathrooms will have sanitizer/disinfectant, all touched areas must be sprayed down with disinfectant (provided by Camp Marshall) prior to and after each use by each person. There will also be handwashing sinks available plus hand sanitizer by all bathrooms.
- Hand sanitizer will be placed in needed locations (Show office, concessions, bathrooms etc.) for use at all times. Extra handwashing stations will be placed in other needed areas for use.
- By coming to Camp Marshall/CMHSS, all parties and persons assume the risk of COVID-19 and all risks associated with COVID-19 and Camp Marshall **and** CMHSS are **not** responsible for any persons becoming ill or symptomatic after attending our shows.
- If you are feeling ill, or have a fever, the day of the event please stay home!
- If you have come in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or a variant within the last 5 days of the show, please stay home!
- Please do not go to the Camp Marshall barns/paddocks/buildings and avoid contact with all private borders/lesson students and families etc.
